Subject Matter: This Second Publication Amended Allocations & Development Management DPD sets out the District Council's:

- **Allocations of land for new housing, employment and other development for the District up to 2033;**
- **Housing Policies, including affordable housing targets and Gypsy, Roma, Traveller policy and allocations; and**
- **Development Management Policies.**

When adopted it will replace the current Allocations & Development Management DPD adopted in 2013 and Core Policy 1 and Core Policy 3 of the Amended Core Strategy DPD. It has been published for a period of public representation before submission to the Secretary of State.

Area Covered: Whole of the Newark and Sherwood District

Publication Period: Monday 25th September 2023 until 5pm on Monday 6th November 2023
