### **Have your say in shaping Newark Town Centre**

We want to identify what residents love most about Newark Town Centre and to look at how the area can be made a better place for residents, visitors, and businesses. That's why we're working with various professional teams to understand what people want from their town centre to help shape its future.

Along with Historic England and architects Allies and Morrison, we're holding a number of public consultation workshops and events throughout the next few months for anyone with an interest in the future of Newark who is able to attend and share their views on Newark Town Centre. Running alongside these will be a series of online surveys to gather lots of useful information to help shape plans for the future of Newark.

All of the information gathered over the next few months will be used to create a new Town Centre Masterplan and Design Code, which will help shape plans for new buildings, spaces and activities in Newark Town Centre.

We encourage you to share the survey, the dates of the workshops and drop-in with your constituents.

The deadline to submit feedback is **Friday 3 November**. An additional survey will be shared later in the year to help further define the plans.
